At the church conference on Wednesday, January 22nd at 6:00 pm, we will discuss and vote on five motions from the Constitution and Bylaws Committee. The changes to the Constitution and Bylaws and a document explaining the five motions can be found below.

In addition, as a reminder, our current Constitution and Bylaws state that every active member is entitled to vote at all elections and on all questions submitted to the church in conference provided the member is present, and that amendments [to the Constitution and Bylaws) shall take effect when approved by two-thirds of the members present at a church conference.

We have a lot to cover at the January 22nd Church Conference. It will be limited to 1 hour and 10 minutes. If this time is exceeded the church conference will be suspended and will resume on January 29th at 6:00 pm.

WILDFIRE


March 29th // 7:00 - 9:00 pm
